The Seven and the Ten: mnemonic in verse and mime

The Seven Sacraments

- 1. Waters of welcome, that's baptism {pouring motion}
- 2. Confirmation is hands and holy chrism.
 {outstretched hand as if on shoulders; then small sign of cross in air at center}
- 3. Bread of his Heart, strength for the day {right hand eats from left}
- 4. Steady forgiveness clears the way {hands outstretched, palms up}
- 5. In sickness, a balm to help us pray. {hands across heart}
- 6. Starting a family is matrimony.

 {Hands clasped, elbows out to the sides, as if the hands were from two people, then outstretched hands as in welcome to children}
- 7. The priest upholds our patrimony. {Sweeping sign of the Cross, outwards}

The Ten Commandments

1. Honor the Lord first of all

{Right hand up; index finger pointing upwards}

2. Let not his name in idleness fall

{Left hand over mouth, head down}

3. At Sunday Mass, heed his call.

{right hand on heart, left cupping the ear)

4. 'Tis blessed to honor your Mom and Dad

{Look right, raising your hand, then left and raise the other}

5. To kill (or wound) our brothers is sad.

{slashing motion, indrawn breath and step back}

6. Impure acts against a marriage

{Pushing away and turn head aside}

7. Or stashing what's stolen in your carriage

{bring shoulder around as if to hide; look over shoulder}

8. Or lying to make our neighbors sad

{shoulders hunch; Hand by mouth to whisper aside}

All these are bad.

9. Don't even think of another's wife

{hands facing outwards from heart, shake head}

10. Don't even want the things in his life.

{hands separate, pull head back}
